

What is Google Classroom?

Think of Google Classroom (GC) as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use GC to share assignments, homework, newsletters, and much more with students

Getting Started

Your child was provided with a secure login and password that is unique to them.

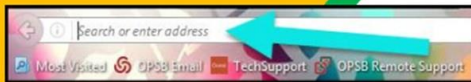


Getting Started



1 Click on the [Google Chrome](#) browser icon.

Getting Started



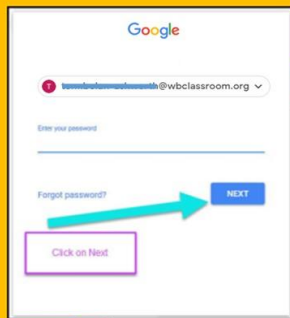
2 Type www.google.com into your web address bar.

3 Click on **SIGN IN** in the upper right hand corner of the browser window.

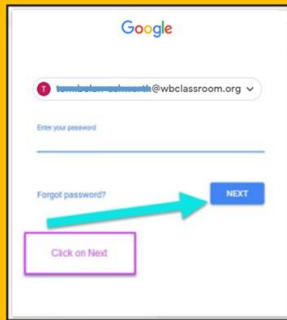

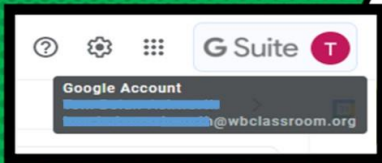
4 Type in your child's **Google Email address** & click "next."

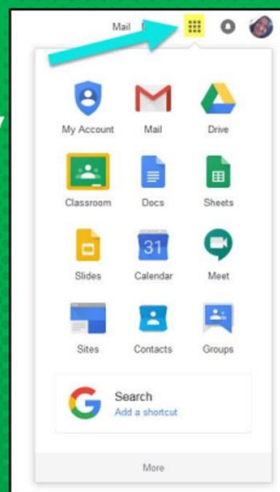
5 Type in your **PASSWORD** & click "next."


Click on the class you wish to view.






